Dear friends,

Slowly but steadily recovering from a global pandemic, we entered 2022 with cautious optimism, until Russia's unprovoked and unjustified invasion of Ukraine disrupted the world as we knew it. War against a sovereign, European nation called into question foundational tenets of the post-Cold War era. The expansive nature of the war's repercussions was immediately evident and it became clear that Europe would never be the same again.

Albeit humble, Friends of Europe's response to the war sought to examine the immediate crises brought on by Russian aggression, as well as the long-term challenges that would or could lie ahead. Our teams took tremendous initiative and care to reformulate planned activities in order to address the unfolding consequences of the war across all of our areas of expertise. Increased defence needs, supply chain disruptions, an influx of refugees, as well as the growing energy and cost-of-living crises, came to the fore. Nevertheless, long-standing challenges persisted. More than ever before, our societies faced the urgency to reinforce and strengthen democracy, equality of opportunity and sustainability.

Our current policy approaches and frameworks were created for societies of the past. In order to reach a more inclusive, sustainable and forward-thinking Europe, we need to radically rethink outdated and obsolete functions of our societies. We must rewrite the social contract. In 2022, we adopted the Renewed Social Contract as the overarching narrative of the organisation's work. As ever, we extend our sincere appreciation to our team for their commitment to our work throughout the past year, as well as our network of members, partners, European Young Leaders (EYL40) and trustees for their continued support.





2022 was a transition year for Friends of Europe, while it established its internal thinking on the Renewed Social Contract and ensured that it becomes the overarching narrative of the organisation's work through 2030. The Renewed Social Contract was embedded across all areas of expertise and is now the lens through which we present ourselves to the world. Every activity we put together is in one way, shape or form connected to the ambition of designing a Renewed Social Contract for Europe.

In the weeks leading up to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine, Friends of Europe launched its <u>Frankly Speaking</u> <u>Podcast</u>. The first season featured Senior Fellows for Peace, Security and Defence, as well as special guests, and focused on the geopolitical crisis and eventual war.
